SYMPTOMS OF HUMAN POISONING

Bleeding from gums and nose, bleeding under the skin, pallor, haemorrhage into and around elbow and knee joints. Blood in urine and faeces.

FIRST AID TREATMENT General Information:

In case of human or animal poisoning, call the Griffon Poison Centre 082-446-8946 (24 hr service). Have this SDS with you when you call. Vitamin K1 (Phytomenadione) is antidotal.

Inhalation: First aid is not generally required. If in doubt, contact a Poisons Information Centre or a doctor.

Skin Contact: Gently brush away excess particles. If on skin and after each baiting, wash thoroughly with soap and water. Wash hands after use.

Eve Contact: Quickly and gently brush particles from eyes. No effects expected. If irritation does occur, flush contaminated eye(s) with lukewarm, gently flowing water for 5 minutes or until the product is removed. Obtain medical advice if irritation becomes painful or lasts more than a few minutes. Take special care if exposed person is wearing contact lenses.

Ingestion: If swallowed, do NOT induce vomiting. Wash mouth with water and contact a Poisons Information Centre, or call a doctor.

<u>DOMESTIC ANIMALS</u>: Immediately transport to a veterinary surgeon. If no signs of intoxication are noted, but bait consumption is suspected, induce vomiting only if ingestion is recent, less than six (6) hours. Use a solution of salty water (2-3 tablespoons salt in a cup of water), place in a soft drink bottle and squirt it down the animal's throat. Vomiting should take place after about 10 minutes. Seek veterinary advice.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Brodifacoum, the active constituent of RODENTHOR Rodenticides, is a long lasting anticoagulant chemical which if ingested by humans, domestic animals or pets, can reduce the clotting power of the blood and haemorrhage may result. Vitamin K1 (Phytomenadione) should be administered urgently by medical, appropriate para-medical personnel or veterinarians. If administered intravenously the injection must be given slowly.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Use only as indicated.

RODENTHOR BLOCK kills after rodents have had one or more feeds. Death will occur 4 to 12 days after a lethal dose has been consumed. Each block weighs 10 g.

BAITING

- Place RODENTHOR BLOCK bait at a suitable number of locations near where rodents have nests or burrows or where they have been feeding or caused damage. Inspect bait points regularly and top-up until rodent activity ceases.
- 2. Dosage rates:

Rats: 5 to 9 blocks at each baiting point at intervals of 5-10 meters.

Mice: 2 to 3 blocks at each baiting point at intervals of 2-5 meters.

- 3. Wear PVC or rubber gloves when handling bait as rodents are deterred by human odour.
- 4. Always make sure that baits are adequately protected from children and non-target animals. It is recommended to use commercially available tamper-resistant bait stations. Where these are not available, hide baits inside pieces of drainage pipe or on trays under tiles, always ensuring that baits remain inaccessible to children and non-target animals.
- Replace completely any bait which has become spoilt or contaminated and dispose of in a responsible manner.
- When rodent activity has ceased, remove uneaten bait and destroy in a responsible manner. It is good practice however, to maintain a few permanent feeding points to prevent reinfestation.
